#### 1 Prospect Tenants' Forum

We meet every other month, and new members are always welcome.

# 3 Other ways in which we influenced decision making at Prospect.

- Tenants' Performance update we developed this quarterly report which is shared with tenants. We agreed on the indicators it includes and the format and style of the report. This meets the Scottish Housing Regulator's Requirements.
- Annual Performance report on Charter once again, we discussed and commented on Prospect's annual performance. We chose landlords for comparison and agreed what should be included in the report.

 We met with a number of Prospect staff (Brendan Fowler, Neil Munro, and Caroline Richards) and discussed projects they were working on.

### 4 Other activities and topics we were interested in.

We were keen to hear more about the work of the Edinburgh Tenants Federation (ETF) this year. Shona Agnew joined us at our July meeting and explained their role and activities. Following this, a couple of us have been to a few ETF meetings and we were shortlisted for Edinburgh Tenants Group of the year at their AGM in November.
